

COVID-19 – Safe Work Practice

Application:	MOL, Public Health & Government guidelines are to be observed and followed by all Duron Ontario Ltd. Employees during the COVID-19 Pandemic
Protective Measures:	 Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) – gloves and face mask/respirator Frequent handwashing with soap & water Use of hand sanitizer Maintain 2 meters (6 feet) distance from others Cover your cough and/or sneeze with tissue paper or elbow Take breaks separately, staggering breaks where necessary to maintain physical distancing Take steps to boost your immune system (vitamins & healthy foods) Sanitize your work area and equipment regularly Temperature monitoring protocol before entering site Use Government of Ontario online self-assessment tool if you start to experience symptoms
Selection & Use:	While working at the office or job site where contact with other Employees is possible
Supervisors' Responsibility:	 Reviewing all of the COVID-19 Policies before anyone enters the site through Site Specific Safety Orientation Toolbox Safety Talks regarding COVID-19 Pandemic Ensuring the daily Pre-Job Safety Instructions (PSI) are being done before work begins Review Safe Work Practice & Hazard Assessment with Workers Follow Government guidelines and ensure that Workers are following these guidelines Ensure a safe and sanitary workplace is provided Screen Workers and Visitors daily to ensure they're not experiencing any cold or flu like symptoms, haven't traveled within the last two weeks and haven't been in contact with a confirmed positive COVID-19 person Ensuring everyone on site is maintaining social distancing – at least 2 meters apart Ensuring everyone on site is wearing the mandatory Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Take every precaution reasonable in the circumstances for the protection of a Worker (OHSA s.27(2)(c)) Follow the Protective Measures described in this Safe Work Practise (SWP)
Workers' Responsibility:	 Follow Government guidelines provided in response to the COVID-19 Pandemic Follow the Protective Measures described in this SWP Participate in the Site-Specific Safety Orientation, Pre-Job Safety Instructions (PSI) and Toolbox Safety Talks Use or wear the Personal Protective Equipment required and/or recommended Not be wasteful with the provided Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Call and inform their Supervisor if they are sick, traveled within the last two weeks or have been in contact with a confirmed COVID-19 infected person Report any contraventions or hazards to the Supervisor or Employer (OHSA s. 28(1)(d)) Work in a manner that is safe and does not put the Worker or others at greater risk
